



Kasetsart University Announcement on  
Qualifications of Persons Eligible for Degree Conferral  
and Regulations for Graduates Attending the Commencement Ceremony

In order for the Commencement Ceremony to progress without obstacles, qualifications of persons eligible for degree conferral and regulations for graduates attending the Commencement Ceremony have been prescribed as follows:

1. Qualifications of persons eligible for degree conferral

1.1 An eligible person must be a graduate approved by Kasetsart University Council or a graduate from the previous academic year permitted to attend the Commencement Ceremony of the current academic year, or a person given an honorary degree by Kasetsart University in that academic year.

1.2 A bachelor's degree graduate must have attended not less than 8 co-curricular activities in all the categories as prescribed by the University.

1.3 A bachelor's degree graduate must have taken the English Proficiency Test as prescribed by the University.

1.4 An eligible person must have participated in all the rehearsals as announced by Kasetsart University.

2. Regulations for graduates attending the Commencement Ceremony

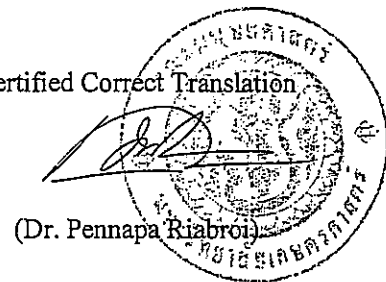
2.1 Every Commencement Ceremony attendee must attend all the Commencement rehearsals and procession arrangement as prescribed by the Rehearsal and Procession Subcommittee.

2.2 Every Commencement Ceremony attendee must strictly attend both pre-rehearsals and final rehearsal whose details are set in the schedule.

2.3 Commencement rehearsal attendees must always bring the identity card issued by the government authority.

## 2.4 The Dress Code

### Pre-rehearsal Days

- **Female graduates (bachelor's degree):** Wear a ceremonial dress, which consists of the university shirt whose collar must be buttoned up, a navy blue skirt, a black belt, and patternless black leather shoes (with heels covered).
- **Female graduates (master's degree and doctor's degree):** Wear a formal dress, which consists of a white short-sleeved shirt, a navy blue skirt, and patternless black leather shoes (with heels covered).
- **Male graduates (bachelor's degree):** Wear a ceremonial dress, which consists of the university shirt, navy blue slacks, Kasersart green necktie, black socks, and patternless black leather shoes (with heels covered).
- **Male graduates (master's degree and doctor's degree):** Wear a formal dress, which consists of a white long-sleeved shirt, navy blue slacks, Kasersart green necktie, black socks, and patternless black leather shoes (with heels covered).

### Final Rehearsal Day and Commencement Day

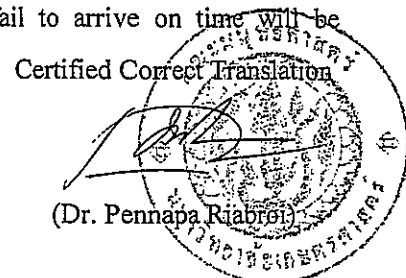
Every Commencement Ceremony attendee must wear the graduation gown and cap, with a tassel in the color representing the faculty. The gown frill must be 1 foot above the ground while standing. No accessories, such as earrings, rings, bracelets, wristwatches, etc. are allowed. No flowers or accessories are to be attached on the graduation gown, except for the Medal of Honor which will be attached on the left chest.

- **Female graduates (bachelor's degree):** Wear the ceremonial dress, which consists of the university shirt whose collar must be buttoned up, a navy blue skirt, beige-colored stockings, and patternless black court shoes.
- **Female graduates (master's degree and doctor's degree):** Wear a white short-sleeved shirt, a navy blue skirt which must be shorter than the graduation gown, beige-colored stockings, and patternless black court shoes.
- **Male graduates (bachelor's degree, master's degree, and doctor's degree):** Wear a ceremonial dress, which consists of a patternless white long-sleeved shirt with a patternless navy blue suit on top, Kasersart University green necktie, patternless black socks, and patternless black leather shoes without horseshoes or metal pieces.

2.5 In the Commencement Ceremony, attendees must report themselves to the Rehearsal and Procession Subcommittee and present the identity card with their photo issued by the government authority.

2.6 The Commencement Ceremony attendees must be punctual for pre-rehearsals, final rehearsal and the Commencement Ceremony. The attendees who fail to arrive on time will be dismissed from the Commencement Ceremony.

2.7 The attendees must abide by the rules prescribed by the Rehearsal and Procession Subcommittee while being in the Commencement Ceremony Hall.

2.8 In the case the attendees ask for postponement of their Commencement attendance with reasonable grounds, it shall be at the discretion of the Rehearsal and Procession Subcommittee Chairman. The application for postponement must be submitted before the Commencement Day in case the incidents are known beforehand; in case of emergency, the application must be submitted within 3 days after the Commencement Day of such faculty.

#### **Prohibitions for the Commencement Ceremony Attendees**

1. Male attendees are prohibited from wearing a black suit, and female attendees are prohibited from wearing a black skirt.

2. Male attendees must not have long hair, beards, and sideburns, and female attendees must have a formal undyed hairstyle.

3. Long and manicured nails are prohibited.

4. The following items are not allowed in the Commencement Ceremony Hall:

4.1 Mobile phones or any communication devices, voice recorders, cameras, and portable fans.

4.2 Wristwatches, wristbands, holy threads, rings, bracelets, earrings, and necklaces.

4.3 Weapons and sharp objects of any kind.

4.4 Cosmetics, such as powder, lipsticks, mirrors, perfume, facial papers and facial tissues.

4.5 Books and any documents.

4.6 Foods and drinks or beverages, dessert, candies, chewing gum, and snacks.

**Remark:** In case of violation, the above items will be confiscated by the Rehearsal and Procession Subcommittee, and the Subcommittee is not responsible for any damage caused to the items.

The Rehearsal and Procession Subcommittee shall have charge and control for the execution of this announcement.
